Repairs and maintenance:

The last of the interior was redecorated last winter and should be fine for next few years. There continues to be few minor repairs and replacements required and, as the Pavilion is now almost 5 years old, this will be a recurring problem. All the repairs and maintenance have been funded by the 100 Club.

Insulation project:

Some progress was made on the insulation project but it proved to be a little beyond our DIY skills and consequently has proved more expensive than envisaged. We do need to buy about 20 more panels but the project should be finished by end of November

Cleaning:

Most of the cleaning has been done again by volunteers which does make a huge difference to the costs. The Cricket Club did get the Pavilion professionally cleaned after Cricket Week which was very much appreciated.

Playing Fields security: after another occurrence of damage to the football pitch during the winter, it is felt some thought should be given to making the grounds secure.
