Rights granted by conveyance of other land 30.10.1953 between EPC and West Ashford RDC (this relates to Water Treatment Works). Requirement on West Ashford RDC to maintain fence between lower part of Water Treatment Works and Recreation Ground, conferred in conveyance of land from EPC to West Ashford RDC2.12.1961. [It seems likely that this was overtaken subsequent agreement with Southern Water, but have not found any paperwork to this effect.] Rights granted by deed 3.11.1970 between West Ashford RDC and KCC Rights granted by transfer of other land 6.8.1975 in respect of Old School Court Varied by Deed 18.1.1979 between EPC and Southern Water Lease to Trustees of Egerton Village Hall, dated 29.04.2003 (125 years from 12/12/2000). Rent of 5p is paid annually. EPC has entered into a number of agreements relating to this title: Lease of the sports fields (which span this title and K355485) to Egerton Playing Fields Association: currently under negotiation. Rent of 5p is paid annually.

K895784 registered 17.1.2006 under Voluntary Registration of Title	Elm Close (north)	Title covers the grass bank between The Street and Elm Close, opposite the School, to just above the Games Barn, where it abuts title K895812 above. This was transferred to EPC by West Ashford RDC (by Deed dated 11.4.1963) in exchange for the plot of land now occupied by Ashford BC's car park. The car park land is included within the title plan for K355485, and enquiries are being made with ABC about the ownership.
K510483	Elm Close (south)	Title covers grassed banks to south of Elm Close, including the steps and roadway down to the

registered 23.9.2003		car park. (The grass to the north of Elm Close and its parking area is owned by Ashford BC.) Title is subject to a series of covenants and restrictions, for example, ABC's right of access to maintain drains.
